Elf shelf CHIMNEY BAG



CAST ON 20 Stitches (Color A) BRICK STITCH PATTERN

Rows 1 + 2 (Color A) Knit All

Row 3 (Color B) * K3, Slip 1 Purlwise *

Row 4 (Color B) * Slip 1, P3 *

Rows 5 + 6 (Color A) Knit All

Row 7 (Color B) K2, Slip 1, * K3, Slip 1 *, K1

Row 8 (Color B) P1, * Slip 1, P3 *, Slip 1, P2

Rows 9 + 10 (Color A) Knit All

Row 11 (Color B) K1, Slip 1, * K3, Slip 1 *, K2

Row 12 (Color B) P2, * Slip 1, P3 *, Slip 1, P1

Rows 13 + 14 (Color A) Knit All

Row 15 (Color B)
Slip 1, * K3, Slip 1 *, K3

Row 16 (Color B) P3, * Slip 1, P3 *, Slip 1

Materials

Bulky Weighted Yarn in 2 Colors 2 - Size 10 US Knitting Needles Tapestry Needle + Scissors

Abbreviations

Size

K: Knit

5" wide x 9" long

P: Purl

Repeat 16 Rows 3 more times until piece measures approximately 9 inches in length, finishing with 2 Knit Rows in Color A and then Bind Off.

Create a second piece, either in garter stitch or the chimney stitch again.

With yarn and tapestry needle, tack side and bottom edges together with right sides facing one another.

Weave in your ends, cut off yarn tail, turn right side out, and you are done!

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Elf shelf BOOTS



Calf Height Boots, make 2

C1:1 - L

Work from Toe of the Boot, Upward

Make a Slip Knot for your First Stitch

| 3 | KFB 2 (4 Sts) |
| 4 | P 4 |
| 5 | KFB 1, K 2, KFB 1 (6 Sts) |
| 6 | P 6 |
| 7 | KFB 1, K 4, KFB 1 (8 Sts) |
| 8 | P 8 |
| 9 | KFB 1, K 6, KFB 1 (10 Sts) |
| 10 | P 10 |
| 11 | K 10 |
| 12 | P 10 |
| 13 | K 10 |
| 14 | P 10 |

Boot Cuff

Change Yarn Color Knit 4 Rows in Garter Stitch, BO, then seam up your boot with the wrong side facing outward. Weave in your ends and turn your boot right side out.

Worsted Weighted Yarn
2 - Size 8 US Knitting Needles
Tapestry Needle; Scissors

Abbreviations

K: Knit KFB: Knit Front and Back

P: Purl BO: Bind Off

Thigh High Boots, make 2

Work Rows 1-14 of Calf Boots in Stockinette Stitch. Change Colors Every 4 Rows, if desired, starting below.

| Rows | Stitch | Rows | Stitch |

| 15 | K 10 | 23 | K 10 |
| 16 | P 10 | 24 | P 10 |
| 17 | K 10 | 25 | K 10 |
| 18 | P 10 | 26 | P 10 |
| 19 | K 10 | 27 | K 10 |
| 20 | P 10 | 28 | P 10 |
| 21 | K 10 | 29 | K 10 |
| 22 | P 10 | 30 | P 10 |

Finish with Boot Cuff Garter Stitch, BO, and Seam.

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TIP STEIT

COZY HAT BAND





Rows Directions

1 & 2 K Row with CC
3 Switch to MC
K Row
4 & 5 * K1, P1 * (Seed Stitch)
P Row

Switch Back to CC

K Row

8 K Row

Bind Off.

Cut yarn. Seam ends together with tapestry needle.

2 - Size 8 US Knitting Needles
Tapestry Needle
Scissors

Abbreviations

K Knit

P Purl

CC Contrasting Color (mine is white)

MC Main Color (mine is red)

Elf Shelf SKIRT

Work from edge of skirt, upward

Long Tail Cast On 72 Stitches with MC

| Rows | Stitch |
|------|-------------------------------|
| 1 | * K2Tog, K1* (48 Sts Rem) |
| 2 | * K2Tog, K1* (32 Sts Rem) |
| 3 | * K2Tog, K1* K2Tog last 2 Sts |
| | (21 Sts Rem) |
| 4 | P |
| 5 | K |
| 6 | Switch to CC, if desired |
| | P |
| 7 | K |
| 8 | Switch back to MC |
| | P |
| 9 | K2Tog first 2 Stitches, then |
| | K entire row (20 Sts Rem) |
| 10 | * K2, P2 * (2x2 Rib Stitch) |
| 11 | * K2, P2 * (2x2 Rib Stitch) |
| | |

Bind Off

Seam Together with Tapestry Needle

MC: Main Color CC: Contrasting Color K: Knit K2Tog: Knit Two Together P: Purl

SNEAKY GOWN

It's a Sneaky Gown because your Elf likes to hide the bathroom tissue paper under her glamorous gown. Too funny!

GOWN

With Ribbon Yarn

- Cast On 16 Stitches, by picking up every other loop.
- Knit 8 Rows, also by picking up every other loop.
- Bind Off

GOWN BAND

With Worsted or Aran Yarn

- Cast On 16 Stitches with the long-tail method
- 10 Rows in 2x2 Rib Stitch
 * Knit 2, Purl 2 *
- Bind Off

Seam ends of your gown and band pieces together with yarn and a tapestry needle.

Make ties by simply cut a piece of ribbon yarn and tie it to the sides of your gown.

If you'd like to make a larger skirt that will fit both front and back around bathroom tissue, simply make 2 gowns to fit on both sides.

Worsted or Aran Weighted Yarn
2 - Size 8 US Knitting Needles
Tapestry Needle
Scissors

TIE STEST

FRILLY SKIRT



FRILLY SKIRT

With Ribbon Yarn

- Cast On 16 Stitches, by picking up every other loop.
- Knit 2 Rows, also by picking up every other loop.
- Bind Off

SKIRT BAND

With Worsted or Aran Yarn

- Cast On 16 Stitches with the long-tail method
- 10 Rows in 2x2 Rib Stitch
 * Knit 2, Purl 2 *
- Bind Off

Seam ends of your skirt and band pieces together with yarn and a tapestry needle.

Make ties by simply cut a piece of ribbon yarn and tie it to the sides of your skirt.

Ribbon Yarn, like Starbella "Flash" Worsted or Aran Weighted Yarn 2 - Size 8 US Knitting Needles Tapestry Needle Scissors



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TIE Shelt

FLYING SCARF





Long Tail Cast On 3 Stitches.

Knit all rows in Garter Stitch, until scarf reaches 9 - 10 inches in length.

Bind Off.

Using your tapestry needle, pull Pipe Cleaner through the middle of your scarf. Fold pipe cleaner ends.

Wrap Scarf around your Elf's neck, and bend scarf as desired.

Create fringes on the ends by tying strands of yarn on each scarf end.

2 - Size 8 US Knitting Needles
Tapestry Needle
